DAIRY CATTLE DIVISION

- 1. Entries in this division must meet all the requirements of the JCLAA General Rules and Regulations.
- 2. Recognized breeds are Ayrshire, Brown Swiss, Guernsey, Holstein, Jersey, Milking Shorthorn and AOB. All other breeds will show together. They can be grade or registered.
- 3. There must be five (5) entries to make a division. If not, they will be placed in all other breeds.
- 4. All heifers that are not registered will be considered grade. All grade heifers will be required to be validated on and date and place determined by the board of directors. Exhibitors showing registered heifers must provide a copy of registration papers to the superintendent on validation date. Any heifer not validated, or the exhibitor does not provide registration papers on validation date will be disqualified and not allowed to show.
- 5. Any class with an excessive number of entries will be split according to withers height.
- 6. All Dairy Heifer substitutions must be made the Saturday prior to the dairy show or will be charged a \$150 substitution fee.
- Exhibitors will follow the dates and times outlined in the show schedule.
- 8. Breed and Reserve Champions will be selected from each breed. A Supreme Champion Heifer will be selected from breed champions. A Reserve Supreme Champion will be selected from the remaining breed champions and the Reserve Breed Champion from the breed from which the Supreme Champion was selected. The Supreme Champion and Reserve Supreme Champion Dairy Cattle will sell in the auction. Supreme Dairy Heifer Champions are not eligible under any circumstances to return to County Show under any ownership.
- 9. Dairy Cattle division show will be a Blow and Go Show allowing sheen and oil only. Any animal with adhesive or artificial colorants will be disqualified from the show. Cattle must be exhibited under halter in the show ring.

Class 1 - Heifers born after September 1, 2024 thru October 31, 2024

Class 2 - Heifers born June 1, 2024 thru August 31, 2024

Class 3 - Heifers born March 1, 2024 thru May 31, 2024

Class 4 - Heifers born December 1, 2023 thru February 28, 2024

Class 5 - Heifers born September 1, 2023 thru November 30, 2023

Class 6 - Heifers born June 1, 2023 thru Aug. 31, 2023

Class 7 - Heifers born December 1, 2022 thru May 31, 2023

10. Each exhibitor is limited to two (2) entries in the dairy cattle division. (5/15/18) Only Johnson County Vocational Ag. Teachers, Johnson County Ext. Agents, and parents of exhibitors will be allowed in staging areas for the Livestock shows. No one except for exhibitors or ring assistants will be allowed in entry alleys to the show ring.
