Fancy Poultry Show Rules

- 1. Exhibition Poultry/Fancies classes are determined by the American Poultry Association standard of perfections, classes of birds that are as follows and would be considered exhibition poultry (excluding broilers). The following are fowl that can be shown under the standard in perfection rules and guidelines: Standard Poultry, Bantam Poultry, and Waterfowl (to include ducks and geese).
- 2. Each exhibitor may enter and show a maximum of two (2) birds.
- 3. All birds must be validated on the date determined by the Poultry Committee. There will not be a validation fee. Exhibitors may validate a maximum of 5 birds. Any issues with validation (ex. lost/damaged band) must be reported immediately to the validation committee and replaced prior to show.
- **<u>4.</u>** Entries must check-in on show day with the Poultry Committee and receive a coop assignment before they are placed in a coop.
- **<u>5.</u>** Each pen will consist of one bird per pen.
- **<u>6.</u>** Birds must not be removed until the end of the show.
- 7. Birds with parasites will be sifted.
- **8.** Unsuitable entries will be sifted.
- **9.** No spectators will be allowed in the cage area during the admittance of the birds.
- **10.** All supplies will be neatly stored under pens as designated for Poultry exhibitors. Adequate care, food and water for poultry are the responsibility of exhibitors.
- **11.** All poultry exhibits will comply with the Pullorum-Typhoid regulations for Poultry Shows in Texas.
- **12.**Classes will be determined based on entries and posted after check-in by the Poultry Committee.
- **13.**Belt Buckles will be awarded to the Champion Showmanship winner in the Junior, Intermediate and Senior age groups of all the Poultry Showmanship Divisions.

All arriving breeding poultry at the show must have proof of Pullorum-Typhoid status. Proof may be documented in three ways:

- Originals from a flock certified as National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP) U. S. Pullorum - Typhoid Clean by the Texas Pullorum Disease and Fowl Typhoid Control Program.
- ii. Originated from a flock certified as Pullorum-Typhoid Clean by the Texas Pullorum Disease and Fowl Typhoid Control Program
- iii. A negative reaction to the Pullorum-Typhoid test conducted by an authorized agent 30 days prior to the show.
