## MARKET GOAT DIVISION

- 1. Entries in this division must meet all the requirements of the JCLAA General Rules and Regulations.
- 2. All goats must be state validated. Validation date and place will be determined by board of directors.
- 3. Does may be entered as market animals.
- 4. All goats will be required to have horns tipped, no sharp tips allowed. Removal of horns is not allowed at the Posse grounds during the show.
- 5. Male goats must be castrated.
- 6. Shearing goats must be shorn to no more than 3/8" from knee and hock up.
- 7. This division is open to any breed or crossbred goat.
- 8. The superintendent shall determine number of goat classes in each division after all goats are weighed in. No maximum weight limit will be enforced, although the goats must carry a minimum weight of 50 lbs. to be considered eligible for the market goat division. Goats not weighing 50 lbs. may be removed from the show grounds after weigh-in. (4/15/25)
- 9. Classes will be split according to weight after weigh-in.
- 10. Exhibitors will follow the dates and times outlined in the show schedule.
- 11. TAH rules require that official scrapie ID tags or a registration tattoo be applied to: All breeding goats (except for commercial goats that have no contact with sheep), all sexually intact shows or exhibitors animals. This rule will be enforced at time of show weigh-in.
- 12. Goat show will be a blow and go show. Any animal with adhesive, powder, or artificial colorants will be disqualified from the show.
- 13. All blankets, leg wraps, muzzles must be removed prior to weigh-in. (4/15/25)
- 14. Each exhibitor is limited to two (2) entries in the market goat division. Only Johnson County Ag. Teachers, Johnson County Ext. Agents, and parents of exhibitors will be allowed in staging areas for the Livestock shows. No one except for exhibitors or ring assistants will be allowed in entry alleys to the show ring.
