MARKET RABBIT DIVISION

- 1. Entries in this division must meet all the requirements of the JCLAA General Rules and Regulations.
- 2. a. Market rabbits can be either be raised or purchased.
 - b. Breeding dates for does is 100 days prior to show.
 - c. Purchased rabbits should be born approximately 70 days prior to show date.
- 3. a. Market rabbits will be validated at approximate 5 weeks of age. Validation time and place will be determined by the board of directors.
 - b. An exhibitor may validate as many bunnies as they want.
 - c. Each exhibitor will have their own validation number.
- 4. a. An exhibitor can only have 2 meat pens.
 - b. A meat pen shall consist of 3 rabbits of the same bred (no crossbreds).
 - c. Total maximum weight is 16.5lbs. and total minimum weight is 9 lbs.
- 5. Exhibitors will follow the dates and times outlined in the show schedule.
- 6. All sick and diseased animals will be dismissed from the show grounds.
- 7. The animals care will be the responsibility of the exhibitor from the time of arrival and until the animals leave the premises
- 8. a. Classes for market rabbit will be broken by total weight per pen.
 - b. Each class will consist of no more than 20 entries.
 - c. Class winners for the meat pen divisions will compete for Grand and Reserve Champions overall.
- 9. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 10th.
- Judging will begin at the conclusion of the Breeding Rabbit Division.
 Showmanship will begin at the conclusion of weigh-in. Showmanship Order: Senior, Intermediate & Junior.
- 11. Rabbits will be released after the conclusion of each Division except for the Grand and Reserve Market Champions which will be put on display until the sale.
- 12. Only Johnson County Vocational Ag. Teachers, Johnson County Ext. Agents, and parents of exhibitors will be allowed in staging areas for the Livestock shows. No one except for exhibitors or ring assistants will be allowed in entry alleys to the show ring.
